O'Connor Coaches have successfully reached the required standards set out by Failte Ireland and have been awarded membership to the Failte Ireland Quality & Standards framework coach operator accreditation scheme for 2013. These coaches have been awarded five star approvals and feature the following extras:

- Three point seat belts
- Fridge
- Climate Control Air Conditioning

- Toilet & wash room
- Lowering front step facility
- Reclining seats
- TV & DVD with road monitors giving passengers at rear of coach full view of road ahead

Spacious Legroom:

Coach seating have been reduced from 51 to 49 seats in order to provide extra legroom between seats and make it more comfortable for the passengers, especially on longer trips.

Coach Seating:

Seats will be allocated on a first come first served basis (excluding the first two pairs on either side - 8 persons - e.g. disability, bad traveller). We will allocate a seat number when you pay your deposit and you will receive a coach ticket which will display your seat number of which we will have a copy. This will be your seat for the entire tour. Therefore it is important to book early if you require a seat towards the front of the coach. These seating arrangements apply to our package tours only, not day trips. We will not allocate seats on a day trip.

When a club books one of these package tours, and fills a coach themselves e.g. if Kilbrittain young at heart group have 49 people going to Wales, then they will fill the coach on their own. We are not responsible for allocating seats on that tour, it is the responsibility of the leader of your group. And if people on that trip require front seats, that has to be arranged with again the group leader. We will give the coach tickets to the people in charge of the group, and they in turn will give a coach ticket to each person travelling on the tour.

NB: GUIDE SEAT IS FOR CREW MEMBERS ONLY. THE GUIDE'S SEAT IS NOT A LICENCED SEAT

TOUR PICK UP POINTS

All our tour pick up points begin at the Celtic Ross Hotel in Rosscarbery, and travel through the following towns where a pick up point has been allocated:

Clonakilty, Bandon, Innishannon, Cork City, Fermoy, Mitchelstown. Further pick up points available.

For groups of 15 or more we will try to facilitate to pick you up in your home town or village, and transfer you to meet up with the main coach at a suitable point en route. We will arrange this with your group about one week prior to the departure date of your tour, or you may join the tour at the port of Larne or Rosslare.

BOOKINGS AND PAYMENTS

- A deposit of €150 per person or €300 per couple is required to book a seat on all tours.
- Full payment for UK tours is due 6 weeks before tour departure date.
- Full payment for Northern Ireland, Wexford/Wicklow, and West Cork tours are due 5 weeks before departure date.
- Please note that final payments for Scottish or Welsh tours are non-refundable if seats are cancelled less than 30 days before tour departure date.
- We advise all passengers intending to travel to take out holiday insurance in the event of illness during or prior to departure of tour.
- We advise all passengers travelling to bring some form of photo identification, preferably a passport in the event of anyone needing to take a flight home before the tour ends due to unforeseen circumstances.



ITINERARY - Tour to the Heart of Scotland

DAY 1 - SUNDAY

Travel to Scotland

Tour pick up points:

Rosscarbery, Clonakilty, Bandon, Innishannon, Cork City, Fermoy, Mitchelstown. Further pickup points available.

We travel via Durrow to start the holiday with a "Full Irish Breakfast" at the Castle Arms Hotel, Durrow, Co Laois. With "comfort stops" along the way our coach will make one last stop at the Carrickdale Hotel, Co Louth to enjoy a light lunch and collect our regular "on-board" guide Barbara who will escort and guide us throughout the tour. We now travel on to Larne to catch the afternoon ferry (2 hours crossing time) from Larne to Cairnryan, Scotland. With free time on board you will have the opportunity to enjoy the on-board facilities.

From Cairnryan, we make the short journey for a one night stop in the family owned Horizon Hotel situated on the seafront in Ayr, Scotland where we will have high tea, bed and breakfast.

DAY 2 - MONDAY

Cruise Loch Lomond & Travel The Trossachs National Park

After breakfast we travel on through Glasgow over its famous Erskin Bridge to the beautiful little village of Luss, situated on the bonnie banks of Loch Lomond. After tea, coffee and scones at the Tarbert Hotel we enjoy a guided cruise of Loch Lomond and on to the Ardlui Hotel at the top of the Loch for a light lunch, enjoy the views and take some photographs.

After lunch, we travel the Trossachs National Park, once home to Scotland's notorious Rob Roy McGregor, to the beautiful Woollen Mills Centre at Callender. Here you will have free time to browse, shop and photograph Haemish - one of the famous Highland cattle breed.

Finish the day in the "Double Tree Hilton Dunblane Hydro Hotel & Leisure Complex set in the medieval town of Dunblane, 5 miles from Stirling City and home of the famous Scottish chef Nick Nairn Restaurant.

Set within 10 acres of private landscaped grounds, this impressive mansion built in the nineteenth century to facilitate ladies and gentlemen wishing to drink or bath in the medicinal values of the spring water of Dunblane, has today been rejuvenated into a luxury elegant hotel. This will be your bed in Central Scotland for the next 4 nights.

DAY 3 - TUESDAY

Stirling Castle & The Famous Grouse Distillery

Today we travel out to discover the history and folklore of Scotland. Our first visit is to Stirling Castle, perched some 250 ft above the town. In the shadow of the nearby historical William Wallace monument we enter the Castle for a guided tour.

A short journey through the Perthshire countryside to discover Scotland's oldest distillery at Glenturret - home of the Famous Grouse whiskey. After lunch at the rooftop restaurant we take a

quided tour of the distillery finishing with The Taste Experience!

After the whiskey experience we travel the short journey to the nearby Crieff Visitor Centre where we have free time to enjoy its shop, garden centre, gallery & antiques and story of the Highland Cattle Drovers Exhibition. Not to be missed here is the world famous Caithness Glass Factory where, from the viewing gallery, you can see glass making in progress.

DAY 4 - WEDNESDAY

Beautiful Glencoe In The Highlands

Today we travel through the highlands of Scotland, its rugged mountains and glens giving us spectacular views and photo opportunities. From the little village of Tyndrum at the bottom we begin the climb over the Bridge of Orchy up through the beautiful mountains and glens of Glencoe – famous in history and song – "The Massacre of Glencoe".

Following tea, coffee & homemade scones and with the beautiful views of Loch Linnhe, we continue to travel along its shores to the town of Fort William - nestling at the foot of Ben Nevis mountain.

For beauty and scenery this will truly be the highlight of your visit to Scotland – a lasting memory!

DAY 5 - THURSDAY

Full Day In Edinburgh

We travel the 1.5 hour journey to Edinburgh, the Capital of Scotland, crossing over the historical Forth Road Bridge capturing the magnificent views across the Firth of Forth on our way to the city centre. Here a local Scottish Blue Badge guide will step on board our coach and take us on a one hour tour of the sights and scenery of the city.

After our city tour the rest of the day in Edinburgh will be free for you to enjoy Scotland's capital city.

Farewell Scottish Evening - Entertainment after dinner in the hotel.

DAY 6 - FRIDAY

Homeward Bound

Today we travel back to Cairnryan to catch our ferry. Approximately 1 hour from the Cairnryan Ferry we stop at the Dowhill Farm Shop and Restaurant for tea, coffee and homemade scones and a chance to purchase some of their home grown produce.

From Cairnryan, we sail back to Larne, Co Antrim and travel onwards to the Carrickdale Hotel, Co Louth (just outside Newry City) for our 3 course evening meal at 5.30 pm.

Here we say farewell to our guide Barbara and continue on route to the various allocated "set down" places along the way home.

ENGLAND (EDEN AND THE MOORS) & CARDIFF CITY

SUNDAY

Tour pick up points:

Rosscarbery, Clonakilty, Bandon, Innishannon, Cork City, Midleton, Dungarvan. Further pickup points available.

We depart West Cork on Sunday afternoon for our overnight stay at the Ferrycarrig Hotel, just outside Wexford town, and enjoy an evening meal here.

MONDAY

After early breakfast we travel the short distance to Rosslare Ferry Port for a four hour crossing to Pembroke in Wales, arriving at 1pm approx. Out of Pembroke we pick up the M4 motorway and travel through South Wales crossing the Severn Bridge to join the M5 Motorway, heading south for Plymouth. We will stop off along the way for comfort stops, and enjoy our evening meal enroute to Plymouth, arriving at Jury's Inn in the city centre, where our tour is based for the next two nights.


TUESDAY

After breakfast we head off to enjoy a visit to Buckfast Abbey, which was founded nearly a thousand years ago, and stood for five hundred years before it was closed by King Henry V111. Today the church is central to the life of the monastery as well as being the focus of the monks daily life. It is also the parish church to the local catholic community. After completing a tour of the Abbey and some free time, we make our way to the Eden Project, described as the 8th Wonder of the World. It has been shortlisted for the best UK Leisure attraction in the British travel awards 2012. So what is Eden? First and foremost it's a garden; the most incredible amazing garden you'll ever visit. Find out how we turned a clay pit into a horticultural heaven! From Eden it's back to Plymouth for our evening meal and overnight accommodation in Jury's Inn.

WEDNESDAY

After breakfast we depart our hotel in Plymouth, and take a scenic route through Dartmoor and Exmoor, the longest and wildest open country in the South of England, taking in a stop at the famous Dartmoor Prison Museum. We continue our journey through the famous Dartmoor National Park, as we make our way towards Moretonhampstead. We eventually join the M5 motorway, and make our way across the Severn Bridge,





arriving at Cardiff International Hotel, where we will be based for the next two nights. After evening meal we will enjoy music and song.

THURSDAY



DAY 1 - MONDAY

With Barbara onboard we travel to Belfast to tour the city taking in the murals on the Falls and Shankill, Stormont and much more.....

Leaving the City Centre behind we travel out to the nearby leafy suburbs of Holywood, Co Down where the luxurious 5* Colloden Estate & Spa, set in 12 acres of secluded gardens, is the jewel in the crown of County Down – built for a Bishop fit for a King! DAY 2 - TUESDAY

Antrim Coast

A visit also to the NEW 2012 on sight Interpretative Centre will highlight the folklore and geology of this wonder of the world!, Here you will have adequate time to visit the "stones", walk the trail or browse through the NEW Interpretative Centre.

Having enjoyed the panoramic scenes of the Antrim Coast we return again to the splendour of the Colloden 5* Estate & Spa to enjoy its luxurious facilities and relax over dinner.

DAY 3 - WEDNESDAY

Titanic - Made in Belfast

Today we travel into Belfast to discover the history of the world famous cruise ship Titanic built in Belfast in 1912. A tour of the NEW Titanic Exhibition Centre will unearth the story behind



the design and build of this amazing luxury liner only to be lost on its maiden voyage! Inside the Centre there is also a souvenir shop and cafes which you will have free time to enjoy.

No trip to Belfast would be complete without "shopping" and your coach will drop you off in the city centre with free time to discover Belfast.

Its off out of Belfast and over to the coastal town of Newcastle, County Down to discover the sister hotel of Culloden – The 4^* Slieve Donard Resort and Spa.

The Slieve Donard Resort & Spa, built as a luxurious Victorian railway hotel, sits on a wonderful panoramic site overlooking the beach and bay at Newcastle in the shadow of the Mourne Mountains. Many famous people have stayed here over the years — most notably Charlie Chaplin and Percy French!

DAY 4 - THURSDAY

Mount Stewart House & Gardens on the Ards Peninsula

DAY 1 - SUNDAY

Pick up day and transfer to Celtic Ross Hotel, Rosscarbery, County Cork.Pipes, Bag-pipes, Whistle, Bodhran and Irish dance.

DAY 2 - MONDAY

After breakfast depart the Celtic Ross Hotel and travel westward to the market town of Skibbereen. Here we visit the local Heritage Centre and enjoy free time in the town.

Continuing westward we pass through the scenic towns of Ballydehob, Schull and Goleen to the beautiful Mizen Head Lighthouse and Visitors' Centre situated on the edge of the Mizen Peninsula – Ireland's most south westerly point! Travelling eastwards our day begins with a visit to the historical harbour town of Cobh – last port of call for the ill fated Titanic – we tour the Heritage Centre and discover the Queenstown Story. Time also here to enjoy this historical town.

From here we make out way to the harbour town of Kinsale and follow the scenic coastal route back to our hotel in Rosscarbery for our evening meal.

At Hook Head, close to Waterford harbour, this stretch of water has witnessed many invasions over the centuries — one of the most famous being that of Strongbow who led the Anglo Norman invasion of Ireland.

On our return journey to our hotel we stop off at Johnstown Castle & Gardens to enjoy the gardens and explore the museum of early rural Ireland artefacts.

On the southern slopes and summit of Sliabh Coillte this arboretum was created by the Irish Government with help from the American Government and opened by President Eamon de Valera in 1968. 2013 is also the 50th anniversary of the death of President JF Kennedy.

From here we travel to Waterford City – Ireland's oldest City to visit and tour its world famous Waterford Crystal Centre. After the tour of the Centre there will be free time for shopping in this vibrant city before travelling to the Elm Tree in Glounthaune, Co Cork for our evening dinner before making our way home.











Breakfasts are served daily. Dinners and some lunches are included as detailed in the itineraries. Any special meal requirements will be made on a request basis only.

SIGHTSEEING

The following terminology is used on the itinerary in regards to sightseeing:

Visit - You will enter a specific site and any applicable fees are included.

View - A brief stop often with a commentary and an opportunity to take photos.

See - You will walk or drive by the site so that you can see it.

A guide is included as necessary as detailed on the itinerary.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE

Baggage handling for one suitcase is included in the tour price at arrival and departure from each tour hotel.

THE TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE:

Passport fees, insurance, laundry, phone calls, beverages, meals not detailed on the itinerary, items of personal nature, excess baggage.

PAYMENTS

The tour must be paid for in full at least six weeks before the scheduled date of departure. If it is not paid for on or before such date the organiser shall have the option to cancel the tour. If the consumer cancels the tour (which cancellation must be notified in writing to the organiser) cancellation charges are payable by the consumer to the organiser.

DEFINITIONS

In the booking form the word 'Organiser' means the person who arranges your transport, accommodation etc, and who offers it as a tour. 'Consumer' means the person who purchases or agrees to purchase the tour or any person on whose behalf one agrees to purchase the tour and who is listed on the booking form or any other person to whom you transfer a tour which the consumer has purchased. 'Retailer' means travel agent.

THE CONTRACT

No contract shall arise until the organiser has received the completed booking form together with a deposit or full payment for the tour and has issued written confirmation of its acceptance to the retailer. This booking form represents the entire agreement between the consumer and the organiser. The organiser reserves the right to terminate this contract if the behaviour or conduct of a consumer either prior to or during the tour is likely to endanger the safety or well being of other consumers in his or her company or that of the consumer himself. The consumer must use the safety belt supplied in the coach. The consumer is reminded that there is a no smoking policy on board the coach.

PUNCTUALITY

Throughout the tour, to ensure everyone enjoys his or her tour, it is the consumer's responsibility to return to the coach at the designated time, details of which will be given clearly to the consumer before disembarkation. The organiser does not accept any responsibility for any expenses incurred by a consumer who is left behind. Every effort will be made to ensure this does not happen, but the consumers' co-operation will be greatly appreciated.

ALL TOURS ARE SUBJECT TO SUFFICIENT BOOKINGS

This means that there must be enough passengers booked on a tour to make it a viable otherwise the tour may be cancelled. In the unlikely event that it

becomes necessary to cancel a tour for this reason, consumers will be informed as soon as possible. All monies paid by consumers will be refunded or may be used by the consumer against another tour with the organiser.

CHANGES TO ARRANGEMENTS

The organiser hereby reserves the right to vary any tour. This includes changes to ferry sailings, advertised accommodation, sightseeing and/or itineraries. This will only happen when situations arise which are beyond the organiser's control.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CANCELLATIONS

More than 5 weeks before departure date any deposit paid shall be forfeited.

Within 3-5 weeks of departure date, 60% of the tour price is forfeited.

Within 2-3 weeks of departure date, 70% of the tour price is forfeited.

Within 1-2 weeks of departure date, 80% of the tour price is forfeited.

Within 7 days of departure date, 100% of the tour price is forfeited.

All cancellation charges apply to each person covered by a booking. Any insurance premium paid is not refundable.

SPECIAL REQUESTS

Special requests (e.g. ground floor accommodation, sea view etc.) shall be communicated by the consumer in writing to the organiser or retailer at the time of making the booking. The organiser shall use reasonable endeavours to fulfil such request. The organiser shall be obliged to provide services only in accordance with special requests where the organiser specifically commits in writing to do so. No liability shall attach to the organiser for failure to comply with a special request which has not being confirmed in writing.

ACCOMMODATION ON REQUEST

Where accommodation is 'on request' an additional charge of \in 10 will be payable by the consumer. The charge will be debited to the tour price once a booking is confirmed. If the organiser is unable to obtain the particular accommodation requested by the consumer, the organiser shall take all reasonable steps to make a comparable alternative available to the consumer. If the accommodation requested by the consumer cannot be confirmed or an alternative offered or if the alternative offered is not acceptable to the consumer, the consumer shall be entitled to a refund of the tour price paid by the organiser less a \in 13 administration charge and the organiser will be discharged from any further liability.

INSURANCE

COMPLAINT

Should a consumer have a problem during the tour he or she should inform the organiser immediately who will endeavour to put things right. If the complaint is not resolved and the consumer has cause for complaint for any reason, whilst touring the following rules must be observed, if the consumer has reason to complain about the accommodation, food or service provided at any guesthouse or hotel that such complaint should be made in the first instance direct to the proprietor or manager of the establishment concerned at the time that the complaint arises, and shall, if the organiser requires, complete a form settling out the detail of the complaint. It is therefore a condition of the contract that a consumer communicates any complaint to the organiser while on tour.

LAWS OF IRELAND

All matters concerning this contract shall be subject to the laws of Ireland and unless the organiser and the consumer agree to the contrary any legal proceedings shall be brought in the Irish Courts which Court both parties hereby acknowledge have exclusive jurisdiction in relation to any legal action brought hereunder.

ERRORS

The organiser has made every effort to ensure accuracy of the booking conditions and other important information however the organiser cannot be held responsible for the printing or typographical errors or errors arising from unforeseen circumstances.
